Tri colour Accessories

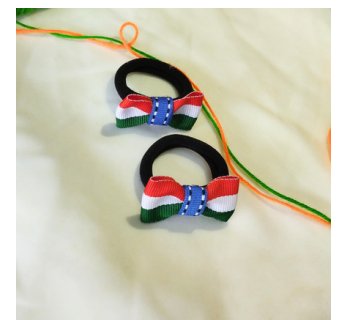
